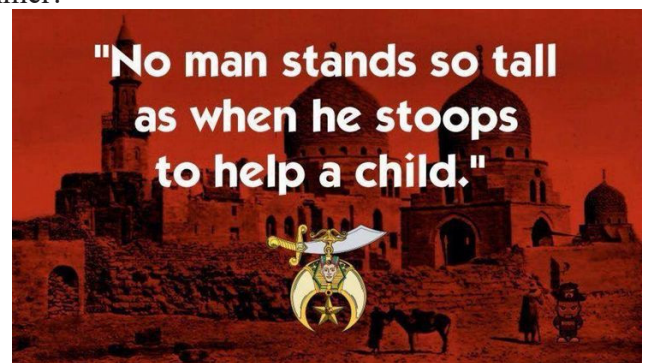
That's all for now. Please say hello when you see me or Renee. We love talking to everyone and look forward to the second half of the year. Safe travels this summer!

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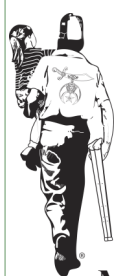
