We conducted a successful Paper Drive at Sam's Club Melbourne the 25th – 27th of April. We collected over \$1700 in three days.

Additionally, we were invited by Space Coast Harley Davidson in Palm Bay to attend their May 24th Memorial Day event, from 1200-1800. We will be displaying a selection of our parade vehicles and reminding the public of our children's hospital activities.
