

Starting a unit is difficult but starting a band is even more complicated. As mentioned last month, you do not have to have any musical background to join the Azan Highlanders. In fact, by joining the Highlanders, you also join the Space Coast Highlanders (formally Melbourne City Pipes and Drums) where you will receive professional instruction on instrument execution and band ensemble. The practices are every Sunday at 3:30pm at the Advent Lutheran Church in Suntree (7550 N Wickham Rd. Melbourne, FL 32940).

WHAT WILL I NEED?

Beginning pipers will need a practice chanter and beginning snare drummers will need a pair of drum sticks and a practice pad. Beginning tenor and bass drummers will need sticks and a sense of rhythm.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- Practice Chanter - \$99
- Drum Sticks - \$20
- Practice Pad - \$25
- Uniform - Once you are playing with the band, there will be a few uniform items to purchase such as a kilt, dress shirt, military shirt, vest, tie, waist belt, cross belt, sporran, hose, and flashes.
- Monthly Dues - \$0 (lessons are free)
