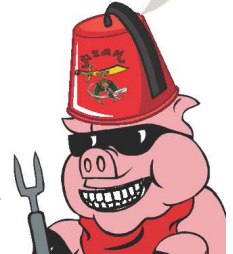

City Pipes and Drums) where you will receive professional instruction on instrument execution and band ensemble. The practices are every Sunday at 3:30pm at the Advent Lutheran Church in Suntree (7550 N Wickham Rd. Melbourne, FL 32940).

WHAT WILL I NEED?

Beginning pipers will need a practice chanter and beginning snare drummers will need a pair of drum sticks and a practice pad. Beginning tenor and bass drummers will need sticks and a sense of rhythm.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- Practice Chanter - \$99
- Drum Sticks - \$20
- Practice Pad - \$25
- Uniform - Once you are playing with the band, there will be a few uniform items to purchase such as a kilt, dress shirt, military shirt, vest, tie, waist belt, cross belt, sporran, hose, and flashes.
- Monthly Dues - \$0 (lessons are free)
